performs his country-rock song "I'm Alabama" as Andrew helps a handful of children paint a portrait of Meyer.

"My daddy is not going to like this," one of the kids says.

"I think he's the head coach for a high school football team," another says.

Near the end of the video, there's the crack of thunder, and one of the kids, dressed as Alabama coaching legend Paul "Bear" Bryant, walks up to the easel and reveals a portrait not of Meyer, but Saban.

Andrew, who's the one who really painted the Saban portrait, says he plans to auction it off at some point and donate part of the proceeds to a yet-to-be-named Alabama charity.


